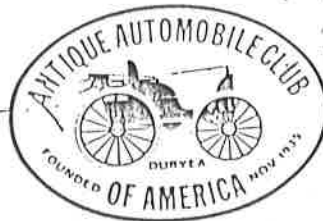

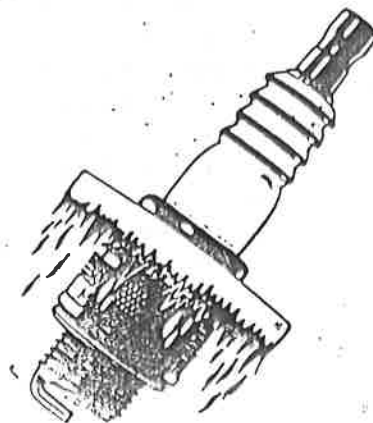

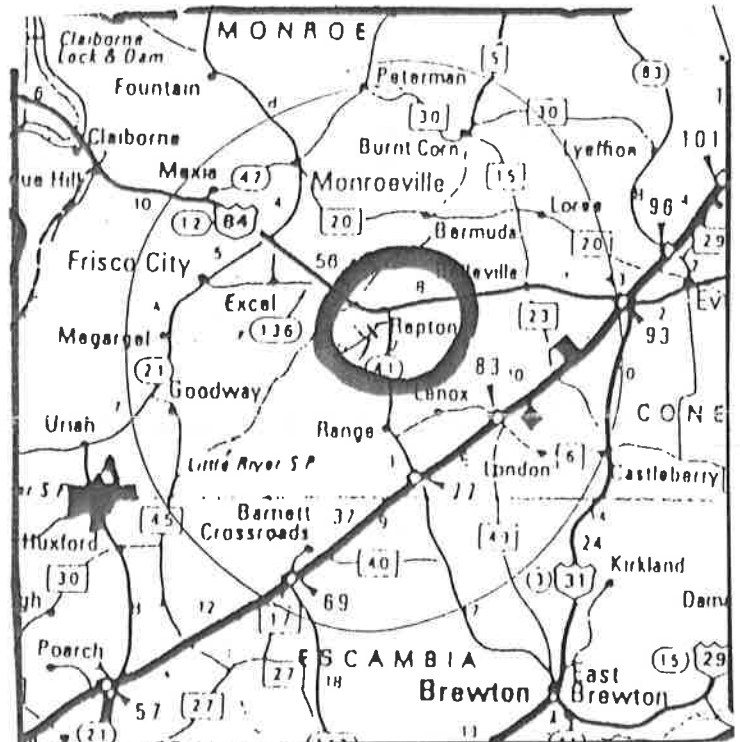

It is all of these things that make both Paula and myself so very proud that we know each and every one of you and consider you all very dear and TRUE FRIENDS!!

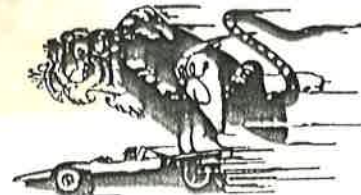

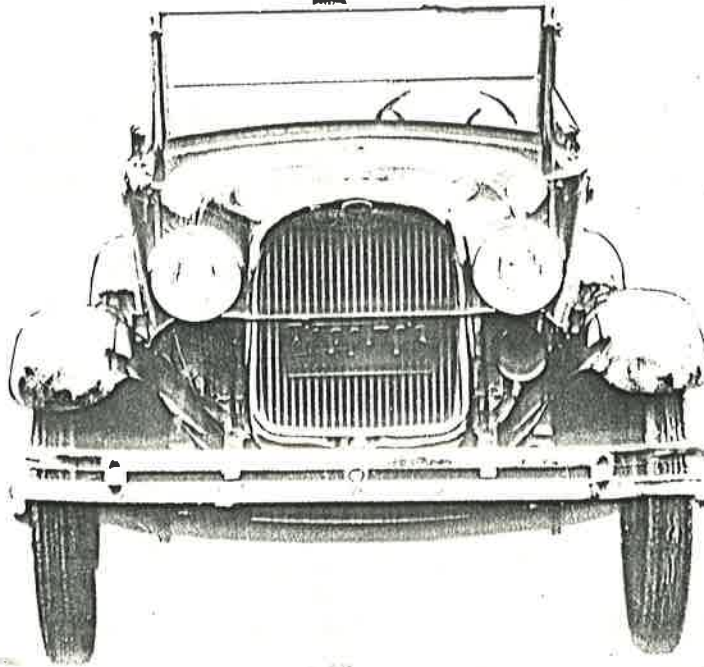
