




## A Little Bit of History


Several times throughout the years, the DSR has taken the 88 mile trip to Monroeville for a visit to Ray Harper's home town. Ray's great great grand dad purchased hundreds of acres for a homestead in 1852 and ran the Anderson Stage Stop on the Old Government Road which connected Montgomery to Mobile. The Anderson Stage Stop is the only stop remaining on the Old Federal Road. The picture below shows Ray's mother, Ora Anderson Harper and her twin sister Eva at the age of 18 standing in front of their home with a 1924 Model T purchased by their father for \$309.55. Ray took their picture again 64 years later in the same place with a similar Model T. He keeps a regular eye out for his dad's original Model T in hopes of bringing it back into the family.
