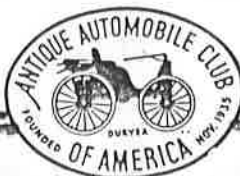

Membership was asked for a certain box containing Club papers, including insurance Policy.

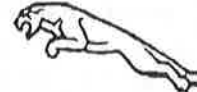

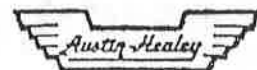

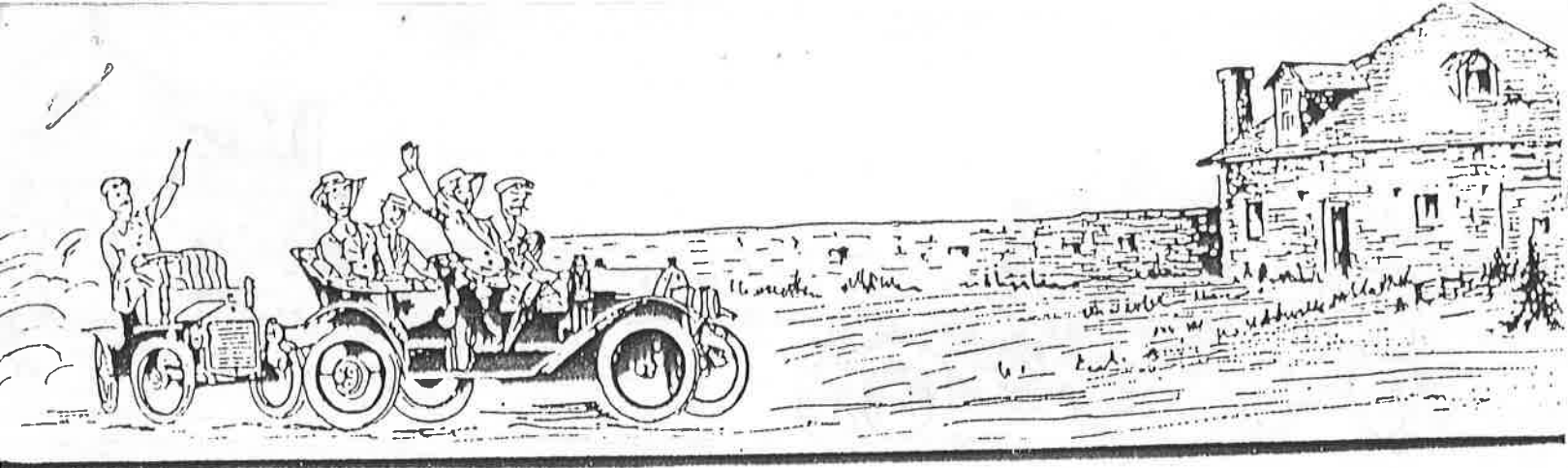

SATURDAY MORNING - Country style breakfast.

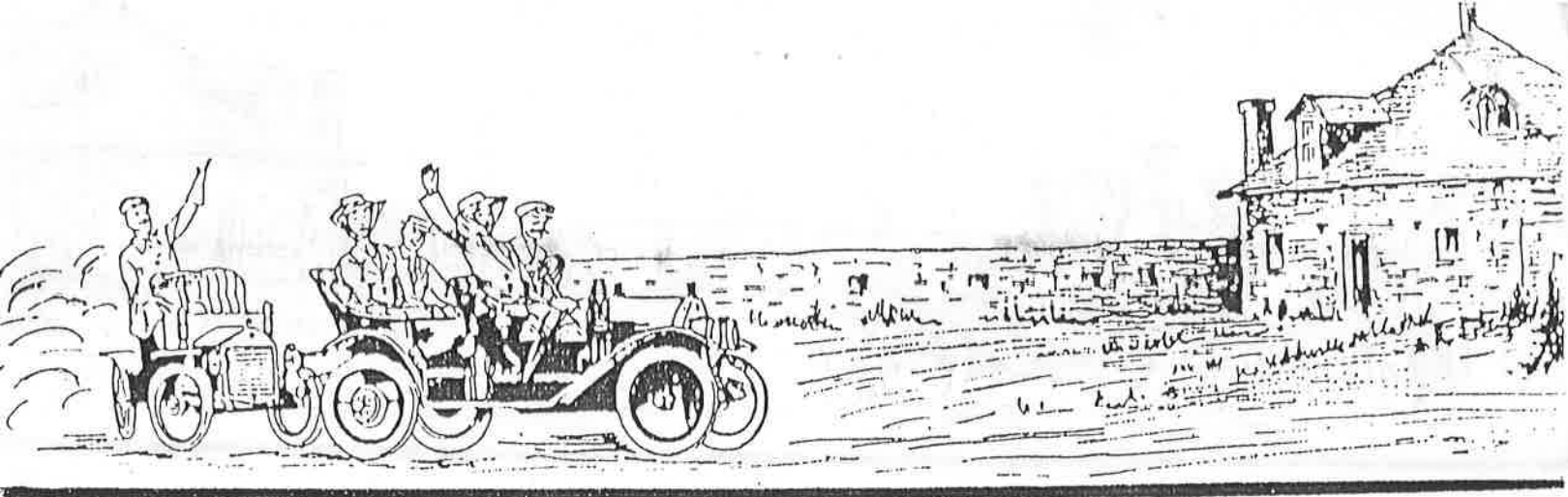

She has moved bag and baggage... She was a silent helper in many ways, with the car Show, with my mailing list, as a part time secretary, she never turned down a call for help.

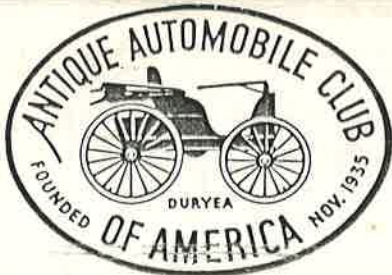
I understand she will try to make 1991 car show.
