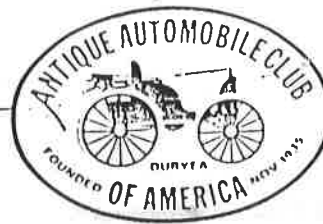

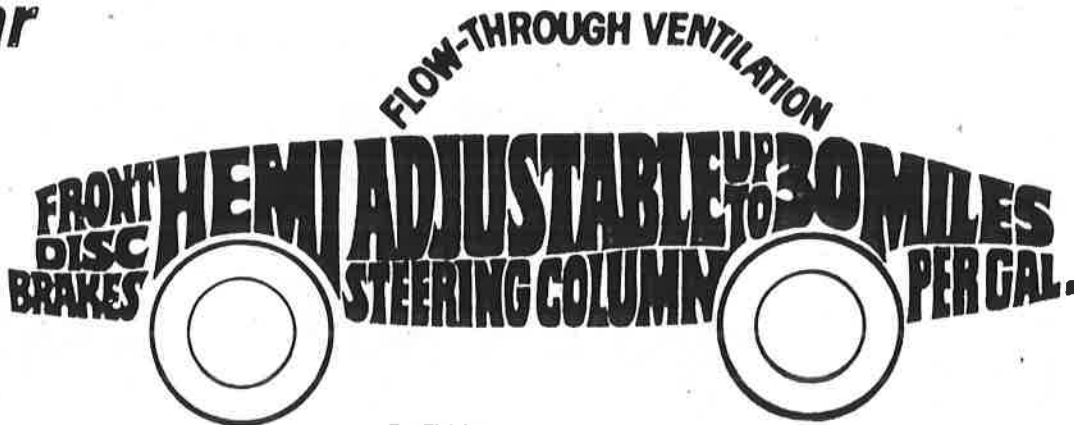

What make and model car does this imaginative word design represent?



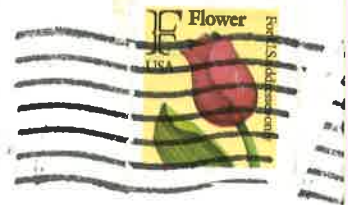
CATAHOULA OUTING
